From Louisville/Hwy 231 South: Follow 231 South into Owensboro. Take Exit 21, or Hwy 144/Downtown Owensboro. Turn right off Exit 21 onto Hwy 144 and continue straight for 4 miles. Hotel will be on the right.

From Nashville/William Natcher Parkway: Follow the KY-9007/Natcher Parkway N to Exit 72A, US 60-E/US 231-N toward Hawesville. Take Exit 21, or Hwy 144/Downtown Owensboro. Turn left off Exit 21 onto Hwy 144 and continue straight for 4 miles. Hotel will be on the right.

From Evansville/Audobon Parkway: Take 60 Bypass West. Follow it until it ends. Veer right onto Hwy 60 East/4th Street. Keep straight for 3.2 miles, then turn left on St Elizabeth Street, heading north. Stay straight on St Elizabeth Street, going across 3rd and 2nd Street. The hotel will be on your left.

From Owensboro-Daviess County Airport: NE on Airport Rd. Turn right onto Airport Rd. Turn right onto W. Parrish Ave for 2.8miles. Turn left onto Frederica St for 0.8miles. Left onto W 2nd Street. Hotel is on the right.
